

## **DIOCESE OF DURHAM Church Buildings Grant and Funding Information**

- **Benefact Trust (Previously** *All Churches Trust***)**: Primary charitable object to promote the Christian religion. Open grants normally fund capital projects and equipment: <a href="https://benefacttrust.co.uk/">https://benefacttrust.co.uk/</a>
- Church Buildings Panel Grants (Diocese of Durham): Your first call for small grants for works to your church buildings. Grants of up to 10% total cost of works and maximum awards of £4,000. Make prior contact with Buildings for Mission Secretary (see contact details below) to discuss application and any required permissions for works prior to submission. There are no deadlines for submission to Panel. Award of grant might engender success in applying to external grant bodies.
  - **Church Buildings Panel Loans:** Same application form to be used when applying for loan from the CBP. Loans usually set at 3% interest and all applications subject to DBF assessment.

- LPOW Grant Scheme Reclaiming VAT on works to listed church buildings:
   The Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme is a government DCMS scheme, administered by Topmark, whereby listed churches can apply to claim back VAT incurred in certain works/ repairs: <a href="http://www.lpwscheme.org.uk/index-2.html">http://www.lpwscheme.org.uk/index-2.html</a> The scheme is extended until 31st March 2025.
- NHCT: (Northumbria Historic Churches Trust): Offer grants of up to £5,000 to help with repairs
  and works projects to churches throughout Durham Diocese. Churches which are not listed may
