1. Large (brass?) jug 17" x 7". In memory from Second World War. Dent on front
Inscription Dedication : "William Parker & Thomas Robson"



2. Discoloured water jug with handle and lid 12" tall with 6" base.



3. Smart silver ciborium. Dedicated "Margaret Frances Ingram 1855 – 1952"



4. Small communion pyx (silver plated?) 3" x 2 ½" "Presented to parish of St Oswin in memory of Gertrude & Violet Spencer."



5. Stainless Steel Shallow Tray 17" x 10". Good condition



6. Small Stainless Steel Tray 9" x 6" with 2 small 3" jugs. Good condition



7. Small stainless steel water jug 2 ½" and 5" bowl (7" rim)



8. Silver Paten 6" Inscription "James Michael Gowens"



9. Silver Paten 6 ½" Shiny – marked with cross – no inscription.



10. Silver Paten 5 ½" Shiny. No inscription.



11. Profiled Silver Paten / Shallow Dish 7" Markings on back: "T I S"



12. Silver pyx 5" with decorative top "Margaret Dodd Walker 1894 – 1970"



13. Silver Chalice 8" good condition. No inscription



14. Silver Chalice 8" with Cinquefoil Base and decorative yellow studs. Good condition.
No inscription.
