

## **Schools Programme Aims**


'Inspiring learning, developing skills and promoting a love of physical activity with programmes to enrich the curriculum of primary school children, and provide targeted learning to secondary school pupils to help them achieve their full potential'.

We do this by supporting schools and working in partnership with schools to develop programmes which meet their needs and link to whole school plans.



# Schools Delivery 2018/19

- 153 Primary Schools
- 50 Secondary Schools
- 35 SEN Schools

- Over 50,000 programme attendances



## **Positive Outcomes**

- Not just about large volume making measurable differences to children is key
- Work is measured and evaluated constantly to check impact is being made
- Outcomes vary by programme but broadly focus on improving;
- -attitudes towards school/learning/subjects
- -attendance
- -behaviour and attitude
- -personal social development / character -health and wellbeing outcomes.

All outcomes are collected in conjunction with schools and supported by case studies.






# **Primary Stars Outcomes**

- 90% of teachers are more confident at delivering PE after our coaches have worked with them
- 85% can differentiate better within their PE lessons
- 87% of pupils enjoy PE more with a Foundation coach
- 77% of pupils increased their nutritional knowledge on Match Fit
- 74% of pupils could identify the four British Values after Onside
- 70% of pupils were more confident to write engaging and purposeful sentences after our English engagement
- 81% of pupils were more enthusiastic towards English following our intervention
- 92% of adults felt more confident to support their child's school life following family football.
