<u>Bats</u>

Would you like to learn more about the bats in your church?

If you think that bats use the interior of your church in the summer, but you don't know which species, the Bats in Churches Project can help you find out. They will loan a Peersonic device (between June until the end of August) that stays in the church for a couple of nights and records bat calls. The project will pay postage, provide instructions and will look through the sound files and give you the results, along with a poster factsheet about any bat species found.
