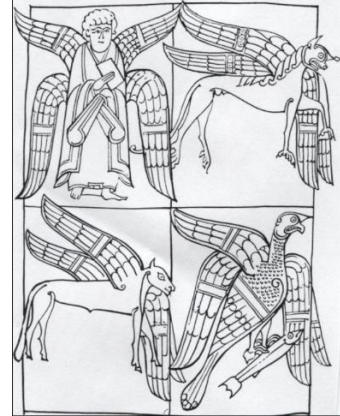
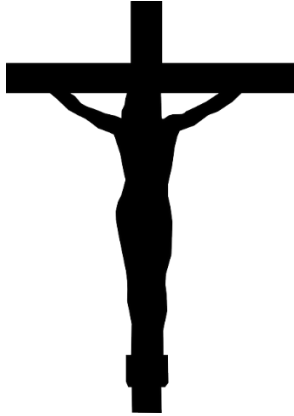

## **“Using the Passion Narratives creatively: A spiritual and theological reflection”.**

‘Early Good Friday’ is an opportunity for clergy and lay ministers who will be leading worship and teaching the Faith during Holy Week, to come aside to be resourced and refreshed themselves.

We are delighted to have the Revd Professor Walter Moberly, Professor of Theology and Biblical Interpretation in the Dept of Theology and Religion in Durham University coming to lead our reflections. Walter, priest of the Diocese, member of Belmont Parish Church *and* leading theological interpreter of the scriptures, will help us to ponder the character and meaning of the different Passion Narratives.

The morning will begin with Morning Prayer in the Cathedral @ 8.45 or refreshments @ 9.30, in Prior’s Hall, with two addresses and space for quiet prayer in the Cathedral and its grounds. The morning will finish as we join in the 12.30 Eucharist in our Cathedral. Do then stay on for lunch in the Undercroft or one of Durham’s many cafés and enjoy some further space and relaxation.
